INTRODUCTION

This User Guide will assist you in using the IS Demonstration Kit (DEM KIT), consisting of an IS switch or IS display module mounted on PC board. A sub-miniature controller manages 64 bitmaps and backlight data.

Bitmap data is controlled by 6-bit parallel TTL level signal and is edited by the "IS Easy Editor," downloaded to the kit via USB Type A-mini B cable (required for connection to a PC).

"IS Easy Editor" is the software to create and edit graphics. A variety of tool functions allows you to customize bitmap images as well as change the setting of the backlight.

Transfer of graphic data is simple with IS Easy Display Controller. An assortment of samples is available, allowing customization of graphic images with ease for your applications.

PRECAUTIONS FOR HANDLING & STORAGE

Handling

1. The IS Series devices are electrostatic sensitive.
2. Avoid excessive force to protect the LCD.
3. Do not exceed 60°C at the LCD level.
4. If the LCD is accidentally broken, avoid contact with the liquid and wash off any liquid spills to the skin or clothing.
5. Do not connect to PC via USB when IS Easy Display Kit is mounted on battery box.
6. Deviation of drive current and temperature may change LCD contrast. Control contrast via contrast adjustment on backside of IS Controller.
7. The IS series devices are not process sealed.
8. Clean cap surface with dry cloth. If further cleaning is needed, wipe with dampened cloth using neutral cleanser and dry with clean cloth. Do not use organic solvent.



Storage

1. Store away from direct sunlight.
2. Keep away from static electricity.
3. Avoid extreme temperatures, high humidity, gaseous substances, and all forms of chemical contamination.

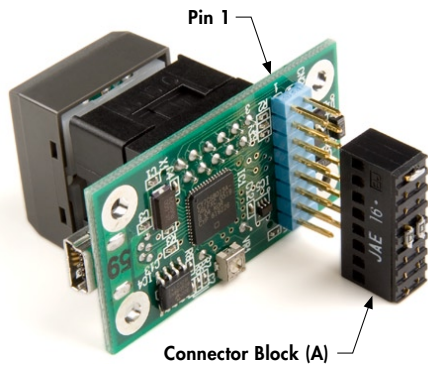

HARDWARE INSTALLATION

The Connector Block (A) is required to illuminate the backlight of the DEM KIT while programming through the USB Type A-mini B cable.



Connect as shown, *prior to connecting to the USB cable.*

Note the orientation of the Connector Block to that of the DEM KIT.

The Connector Block is used **ONLY** during the programming phase; it is not used with the Battery Box option.

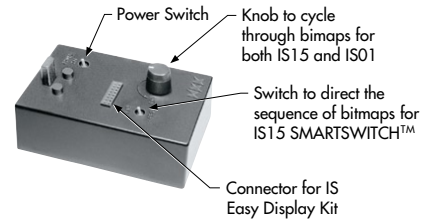
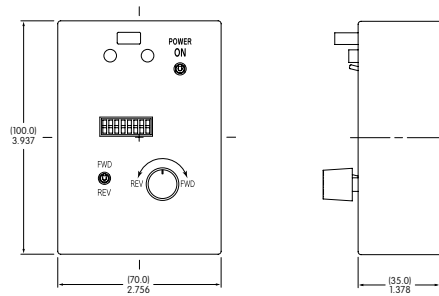
(OPTIONAL) BATTERY BOX SPECIFICATIONS

The Battery Box provides portability to demonstrate functionality without any system connections.

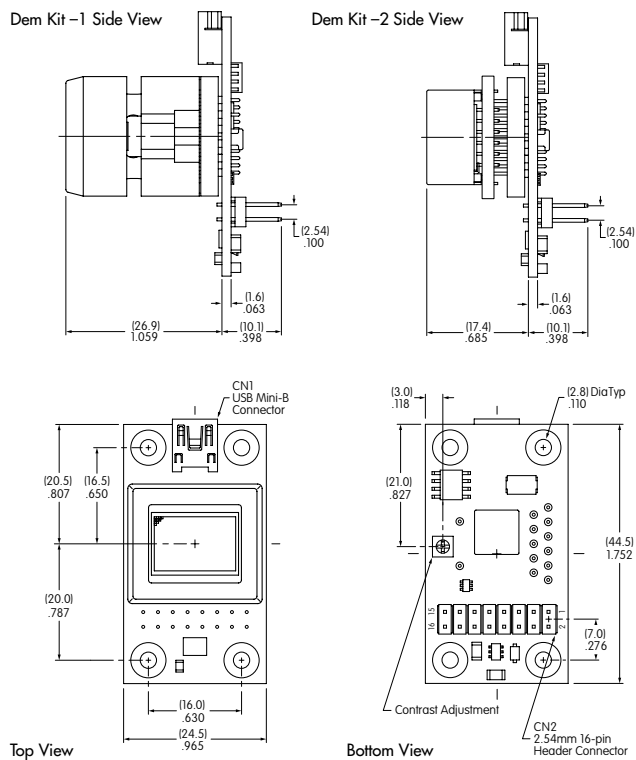
- Power Switch activates power
- FWD/REV Switch directs sequences of bitmaps for IS15 SMARTSWITCH™
- Knob for cycling bitmaps may also simulate animation
- Socket to mount IS Easy Display Controller
- Battery holder accommodates four (4) AA alkaline batteries (not included)

TYPICAL DEM KIT DIMENSIONS



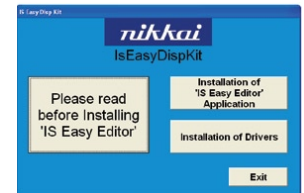
IMPORTANT! READ BEFORE SOFTWARE INSTALLATION

1. Read installation manual on CD (See Figure A).
2. **Do not connect hardware (IS Easy Display Controller) until installation of drivers.**
3. Turn off all resident software (i.e., antivirus software) before beginning installation.
4. Make sure you have administrative rights to install software on your computer.
5. Minimum system requirements:
 - CPU Pentium or compatible processor
 - OS Windows XP Professional, Windows XP Home Edition
Windows 2000 Professional (Service Pack 2 or later)
Windows 98 Second Edition
 - RAM 128MB
 - Disk Space 60MB of available space
 - Browser Internet Explorer 6.0 or later

SOFTWARE INSTALLATION

Application

1. Click on "Installation of 'IS Easy Editor' Application" (see Figure A). "End User License Agreement" window appears. Click "Agree" to continue.
2. Follow the onscreen instructions to load your software and configure the settings.
3. "Install Complete" window appears. Click "Finish".



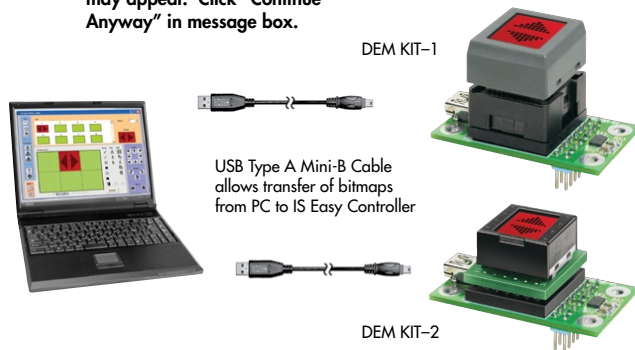
SOFTWARE INSTALLATION (CONTINUED)

- Installation window opens again (Figure A). Continue to install drivers.
- Click on "Installation of Drivers" and follow the onscreen instructions. After installing drivers, follow directions as shown in Figure B.

NOTE: If using Windows XP, a warning message "has not passed Windows Logo testing" may appear. Click "Continue Anyway" in message box.



Uninstall

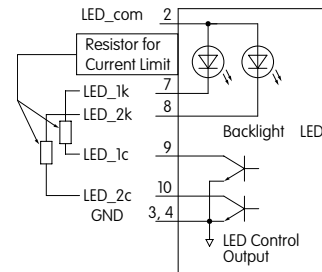
- To uninstall "IS Easy Editor", locate "Add or Remove Programs" in Start/Control Panel.
- Select "IS Easy Editor" and click "Change/Remove".

CONTROLLING INFORMATION (CONTINUED)

Control of Backlight LEDs

For LED control, settings of "IS Easy Editor" are transferred to IS Display Controller via switching transistors connected to LED_1c/LED_2c.

- To activate LED backlight, supply power to LEDs and insert resistor for current limitation.
- Drive backlight LEDs at voltage two (2) times greater than forward voltage of LEDs.
- Between LED_1k-LED_1c or LED_2k-LED_2c, insert resistors for current limitation as displayed in diagram below.

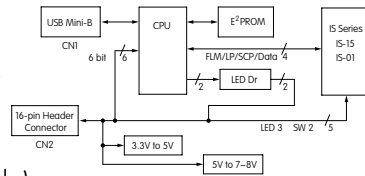


NOTE: Consult factory if using IS Switch or Display other than what is included in DEM KIT.

BLOCK DIAGRAM

Functions of IS Easy Display Controller

- CN1 Connector (USB Mini-B Connector)
Transfers bitmaps created on PC to IS Easy Controller via USB Type A Mini-B Cable
- CN2 Connector (2.54mm pitch 16-pin header)
Connector for power supply, GND, switch operation, backlight LED control and selection of bitmaps

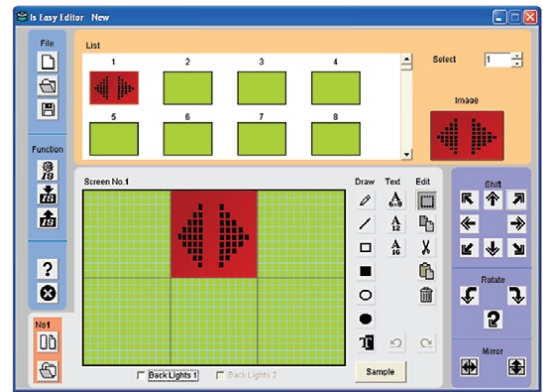
Control of Data

Bitmap data is transferred to IS Easy Display Controller by setting the 6-bits parallel TTL level signals (terminals 11~16).

To display desired bitmaps in "IS Easy Editor", refer to diagram below and set appropriate values to terminals.
