Description

XCA170 is a 350V, 100mA, 50Ω , normally open (1-Form-A) solid state relay featuring high sensitivity. It uses optically coupled MOSFET technology to provide $3750V_{rms}$ of input to output isolation. The efficient MOSFET switches and photovoltaic die use Clare's patented OptoMOS architecture. The optically-coupled output is controlled by a highly efficient GaAlAs infrared LED.

The XCA170 can be used to replace mechanical relays, and it offers the superior reliability associated with semiconductor devices. Because it has no moving parts, it offers faster, bounce-free switching in a more compact surface mount or through hole package.

Moisture Sensitivity

Board Wash

Clare recommends the use of no-clean flux formulations. However, board washing to remove flux residue is acceptable. Since Clare employs the use of silicone coating as an optical waveguide in many of its optically isolated products, the use of a short drying bake could be necessary if a wash is used after solder reflow processes. Chlorine- or Fluorine-based solvents or fluxes should not be used. Cleaning methods that employ ultrasonic energy should not be used.











