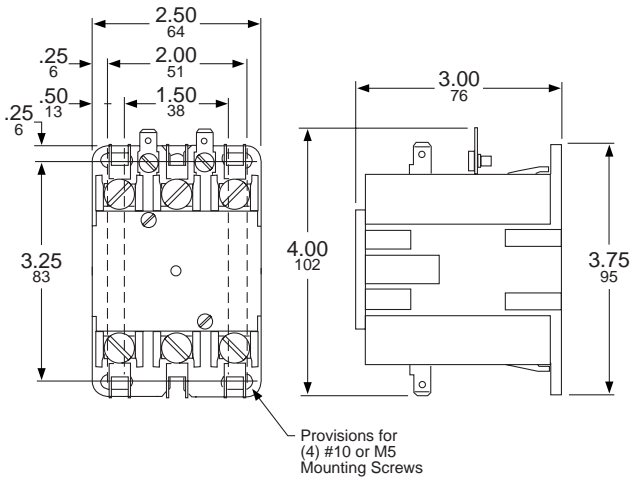
Class 8910 — Types DP, DPA and SYD Approximate Dimensions



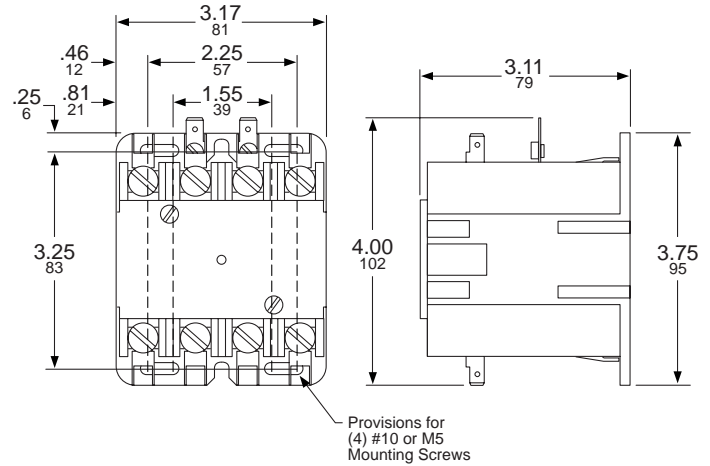

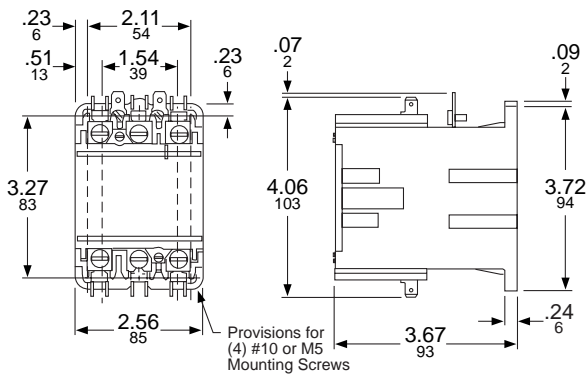
Type DP — 2-Pole

The Type DPA fusible contactor provides an integrally mounted fuse block with fuse clips electrically connected to the contactor. This factory assembled unit not only provides space savings but reduces installation cost as well, with only six field connections for a three pole unit and featuring one unit for two functions, i.e., short circuit protection for branch circuits and remote or manual power circuit interruption. The fusible contactor thus meets the provisions of the National Electric Code, Article 424 for overcurrent protection as well as limit controls for fixed electric space heating.

By a unique fuse clip arrangement, these devices can accommodate a variety of fuses for other electrical or electronic applications. This fused cover will accommodate the Type SC 300 volt fuse which is UL approved under Type G as well as the standard 1³/₃₂" by 1¹/₂" fuses.

Only UL Listed, Class G, K, H or J fuses meet branch circuit requirements when applied in accordance with NEC Article 240. Supplementary fuses shown may be used for additional equipment protection as defined in NEC 240-30. Consult manufacturer of selected fuse for proper application.

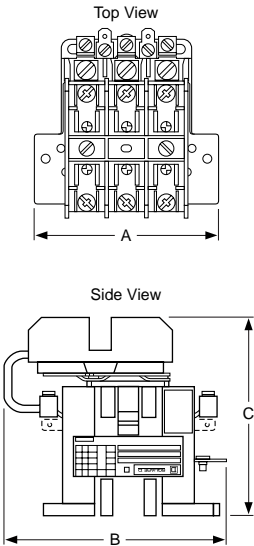

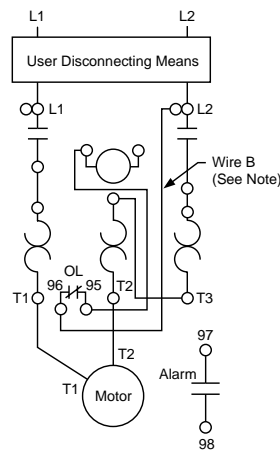

Single-Phase 2-Wire System

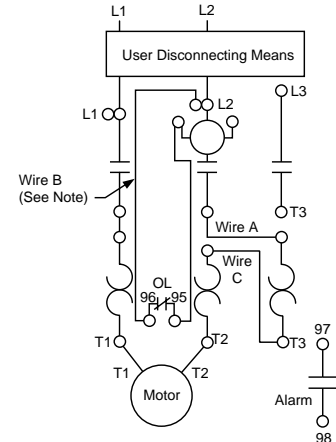


Three-Phase 3-Wire System

Class 8965 Type DPR reversing/hoist contactors are designed for the control of motors in hoists, overhead doors, small elevators, commercial laundry equipment, and other related products which use reversing motors. They are rated to perform in the short periods of jogging experienced in hoist service.

The coils are designed to operate on line voltages of 85% to 110% of rated voltage, and are for applications at 50 or 60 Hz only. Coils are easily replaced with external base removed.

Auxiliary contacts may be easily field-added to any Class 8965 reversing contactor. Type DPR contactors accept one auxiliary contact module with up to two isolated circuits per side (two modules per device). When auxiliary contacts are ordered separately, two modules are normally used for each device; one for forward, one for reverse.
