




1. SCOPE




FIGURE 3. Logic diagram.






FIGURE 4. Switching waveforms and test circuit.

4. VERIFICATION

- 4.1 <u>Sampling and inspection</u>. For device classes Q and V, sampling and inspection procedures shall be in accordance with MIL-PRF-38535 or as modified in the device manufacturer's Quality Management (QM) plan. The modification in the QM plan shall not affect the form, fit, or function as described herein. For device class M, sampling and inspection procedures shall be in accordance with MIL-PRF-38535, appendix A.
- 4.2 <u>Screening</u>. For device classes Q and V, screening shall be in accordance with MIL-PRF-38535, and shall be conducted on all devices prior to qualification and technology conformance inspection. For device class M, screening shall be in accordance with method 5004 of MIL-STD-883, and shall be conducted on all devices prior to quality conformance inspection.
 - 4.2.1 Additional criteria for device class M.
 - a. Burn-in test, method 1015 of MIL-STD-883.
 - (1) Test condition A, B, C, or D. The test circuit shall be maintained by the manufacturer under document revision level control and shall be made available to the preparing or acquiring activity upon request. The test circuit shall specify the inputs, outputs, biases, and power dissipation, as applicable, in accordance with the intent specified in method 1015.
 - (2) $T_A = +125^{\circ}C$, minimum.
 - b. Interim and final electrical test parameters shall be as specified in table II herein.
 - 4.2.2 Additional criteria for device classes Q and V.
 - a. The burn-in test duration, test condition and test temperature, or approved alternatives shall be as specified in the device manufacturer's QM plan in accordance with MIL-PRF-38535. The burn-in test circuit shall be maintained under document revision level control of the device manufacturer's Technology Review Board (TRB) in accordance with MIL-PRF-38535 and shall be made available to the acquiring or preparing activity upon request. The test circuit shall specify the inputs, outputs, biases, and power dissipation, as applicable, in accordance with the intent specified in method 1015 of MIL-STD-883.
 - b. Interim and final electrical test parameters shall be as specified in table II herein.
 - Additional screening for device class V beyond the requirements of device class Q shall be as specified in MIL-PRF-38535, appendix B.
- 4.3 Qualification inspection for device classes Q and V. Qualification inspection for device classes Q and V shall be in accordance with MIL-PRF-38535. Inspections to be performed shall be those specified in MIL-PRF-38535 and herein for groups A, B, C, D, and E inspections (see 4.4.1 through 4.4.4).
- 4.4 <u>Conformance inspection</u>. Technology conformance inspection for classes Q and V shall be in accordance with MIL-PRF-38535 including groups A, B, C, D, and E inspections and as specified. Quality conformance inspection for device class M shall be in accordance with MIL-PRF-38535, appendix A and as specified herein. Inspections to be performed for device class M shall be those specified in method 5005 of MIL-STD-883 and herein for groups A, B, C, D, and E inspections (see 4.4.1 through 4.4.4).
 - 4.4.1 Group A inspection.
 - a. Tests shall be as specified in table II herein.
 - b. C_{IN} and C_{PD} shall be measured only for initial qualification and after process or design changes which may affect capacitance. C_{IN} shall be measured between the designated terminal and GND at a frequency of 1 MHz. C_{PD} shall be tested in accordance with the latest revision of JEDEC Standard No. 20 and table I herein. For C_{IN} and C_{PD}, test all applicable pins on five devices with zero failures.
 - c. For device class M, subgroups 7 and 8 tests shall be sufficient to verify the truth table in figure 2 herein. The test vectors used to verify the truth table shall test all possible input to output logic patterns of each function of the device. For device classes Q and V, subgroups 7 and 8 shall include verifying the functionality of the device.

- 4.4.2 Group C inspection. The group C inspection end-point electrical parameters shall be as specified in table II herein.
- 4.4.2.1 Additional criteria for device class M. Steady-state life test conditions, method 1005 of MIL-STD-883:
 - a. Test condition A, B, C, or D. The test circuit shall be maintained by the manufacturer under document revision level control and shall be made available to the preparing or acquiring activity upon request. The test circuit shall specify the inputs, outputs, biases, and power dissipation, as applicable, in accordance with the intent specified in method 1005 of MIL-STD-883.
 - b. $T_A = +125$ °C, minimum.
 - c. Test duration: 1,000 hours, except as permitted by method 1005 of MIL-STD-883.
- 4.4.2.2 Additional criteria for device classes Q and V. The steady-state life test duration, test condition and test temperature, or approved alternatives shall be as specified in the device manufacturer's QM plan in accordance with MIL-PRF-38535. The test circuit shall be maintained under document revision level control by the device manufacturer's TRB in accordance with MIL-PRF-38535 and shall be made available to the acquiring or preparing activity upon request. The test circuit shall specify the inputs, outputs, biases, and power dissipation, as applicable, in accordance with the intent specified in method 1005 of MIL-STD-883.
 - 4.4.3 Group D inspection. The group D inspection end-point electrical parameters shall be as specified in table II herein.

- 4.4.4 <u>Group E inspection</u>. Group E inspection is required only for parts intended to be marked as radiation hardness assured (see 3.5 herein).
 - a. End-point electrical parameters shall be as specified in table II herein.
 - b. For device classes Q and V, the devices or test vehicle shall be subjected to radiation hardness assured tests as specified in MIL-PRF-38535 for the RHA level being tested. For device class M, the devices shall be subjected to radiation hardness assured tests as specified in MIL-PRF-38535, appendix A for the RHA level being tested. All device classes must meet the postirradiation end-point electrical parameter limits as defined in table I at $T_A = +25$ °C, after exposure, to the subgroups specified in table II herein.
- 4.4.4.1 <u>Total dose irradiation testing</u>. Total dose irradiation testing shall be performed in accordance with MIL-STD-883, method 1019, condition A, and as specified herein. Prior to and during total dose irradiation characterization and testing, the devices for characterization shall be biased so that 50 percent are at inputs high and 50 percent are at inputs low, and the devices for testing shall be biased to the worst case condition established during characterization. Devices shall be biased as follows:

Device type 01:

- 4.4.4.1.1 <u>Accelerated annealing test</u>. Accelerated annealing tests shall be performed on classes M, Q, and V devices requiring a RHA level greater than 5k rads (Si). The post-anneal end-point electrical parameter limits shall be as specified in table I herein and shall be the pre-irradiation end-point electrical parameter limit at $\pm 25^{\circ}$ C. Testing shall be performed at initial qualification and after any design or process changes which may affect the RHA response of the device.
 - 4.5 Methods of inspection. Methods of inspection shall be specified as follows:
- 4.5.1 <u>Voltage and current</u>. Unless otherwise specified, all voltages given are referenced to the microcircuit GND terminal. Currents given are conventional current and positive when flowing into the referenced terminal.

- 5.1 <u>Packaging requirements</u>. The requirements for packaging shall be in accordance with MIL-PRF-38535 for device classes Q and V or MIL-PRF-38535, appendix A for device class M.
 - 6. NOTES
- 6.1 <u>Intended use</u>. Microcircuits conforming to this drawing are intended for use for Government microcircuit applications (original equipment), design applications, and logistics purposes.
- 6.1.1 Replaceability. Microcircuits covered by this drawing will replace the same generic device covered by a contractor-prepared specification or drawing.
- 6.2 <u>Configuration control of SMD's</u>. All proposed changes to existing SMD's will be coordinated with the users of record for the individual documents. This coordination will be accomplished using DD Form 1692, Engineering Change Proposal.
- 6.3 <u>Record of users</u>.
