


Figure 1. Forward Current vs. Forward Voltage




Figure 2. Max. Average Forward Current vs. Ambient Temperature






Figure 3. Reverse Current vs. Junction Temperature




Figure 4. Max. Reverse Power Dissipation vs. Junction Temperature




Figure 5. Diode Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage




Figure 6. Max. Reverse Recovery Time vs. Forward Current




Figure 7. Max. Reverse Recovery Charge vs. Forward Current





Figure 8. Thermal Response


