

NTE517 Silicon High Voltage Plastic Rectifier for Industrial and Microwave Oven

Features:

- Controlled Avalanche Characteristic Combined with the Ability to Dissipate Reverse Power
- Low Forward Voltage Drop
- Typical I_R less than $0.1\mu A$
- High Overload Surge Capacity
