




V_{DS} - Drain-to-Source Voltage (V)



On-Resistance vs. Drain Current and Gate Voltage




I_D - Drain Current (A)




V_{GS} - Gate-to-Source Voltage (V)

 $V_{\mbox{\footnotesize DS}}$ - Drain-to-Source Voltage (V)






On-Resistance vs. Junction Temperature








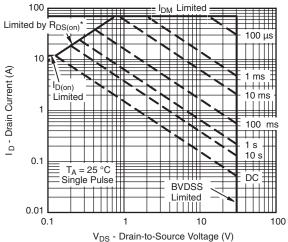
Source-Drain Diode Forward Voltage







Single Pulse Power (Junction-to-Ambient)






Safe Operating Area, Junction-to-Ambient

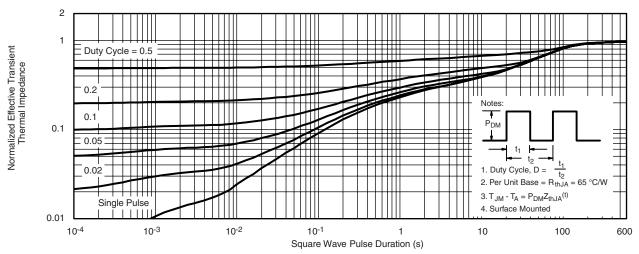




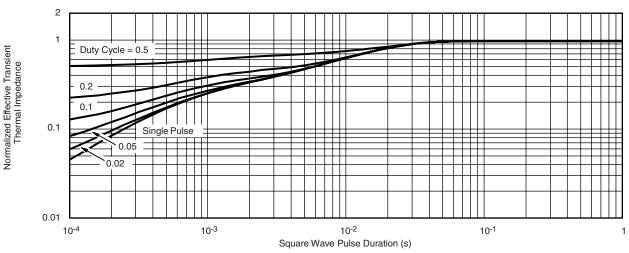
