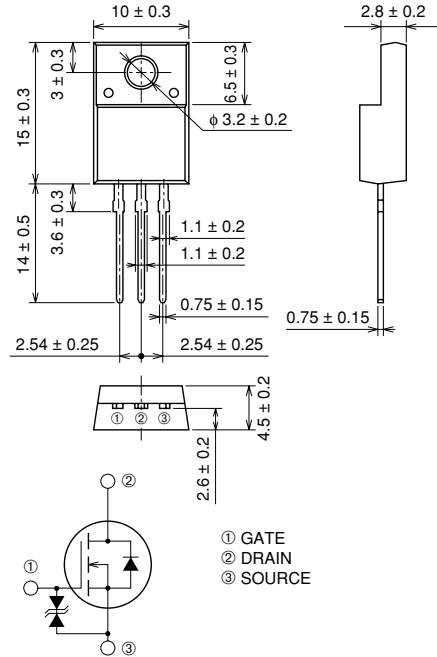

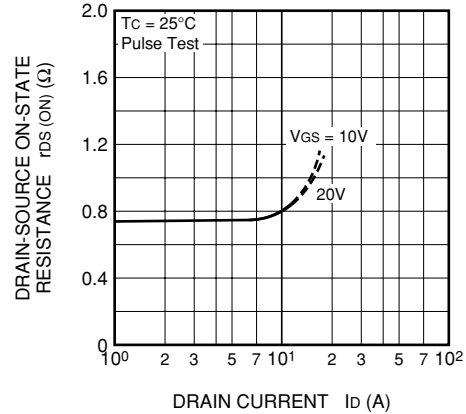

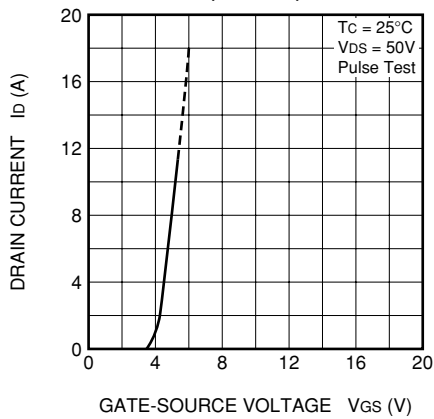
ON-STATE VOLTAGE VS. GATE-SOURCE VOLTAGE (TYPICAL)



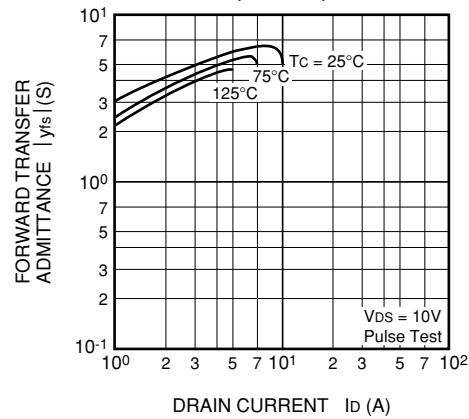
ON-STATE RESISTANCE VS. DRAIN CURRENT (TYPICAL)



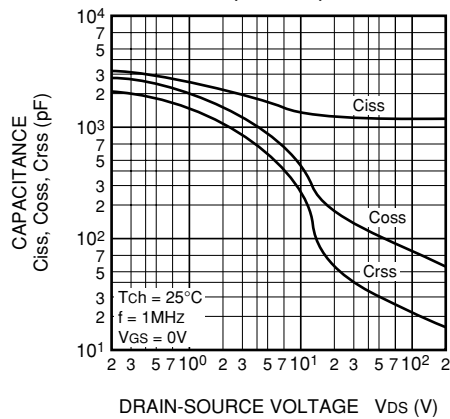
TRANSFER CHARACTERISTICS (TYPICAL)
