




Fig. 1 - Typ. Thermal Resistance vs. Lead Length




Fig. 2 - Forward Current vs. Forward Voltage




Fig. 3 - Max. Average Forward Current vs. Ambient Temperature




Fig. 4 - Reverse Current vs. Junction Temperature

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


Fig. 5 - Max. Reverse Power Dissipation vs. Junction Temperature





Fig. 6 - Diode Capacitance vs. Reverse Voltage
