




Figure 1. DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current

Figure 2. Collector Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current




Figure 3. Base Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current

Figure 4. Base Emitter Voltage vs. Collector Current




Figure 5. Current Gain Bandwidth Product vs. Collector Current




Figure 6. Saturation Region




Figure 7. Temperature Coefficients




Figure 9. DC Current Gain vs. Collector Current

Figure 10. Collector Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current




Figure 11. Base Emitter Saturation Voltage vs. Collector Current

Figure 12. Base Emitter Voltage vs. Collector Current




Figure 13. Current Gain Bandwidth Product vs. Collector Current




Figure 14. Saturation Region




Figure 15. Temperature Coefficients





Figure 17. Safe Operating Area




