FEATURES

- Access time: 45, 70, 100 ns
- Low active power: 70 mW
- Low standby power
 - 60 μ W CMOS standby
- Fully static operation: no clock or refresh required
- TTL compatible inputs and outputs
- Single 3.3V power supply

DESCRIPTION

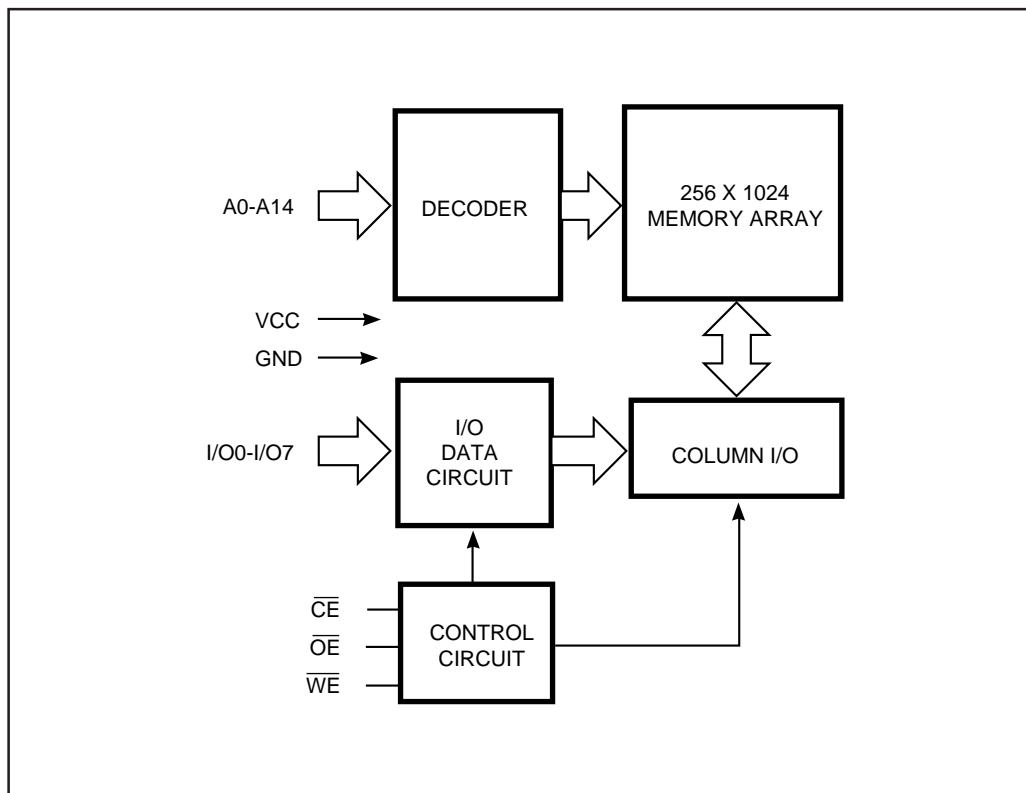
The *ICSI* IC62LV256 is a low power, 32, 768-word by 8-bit static RAM. It is fabricated using *ICSI*'s high-performance CMOS double-metal technology.

When \overline{CE} is HIGH (deselected), the device assumes a standby mode at which the power dissipation is reduced to 20 μ W (typical) with CMOS input levels.

Easy memory expansion is provided by using an active LOW Chip Enable (\overline{CE}) input and an active LOW Output Enable (\overline{OE}) input. The active LOW Write Enable (\overline{WE}) controls both writing and reading of the memory.

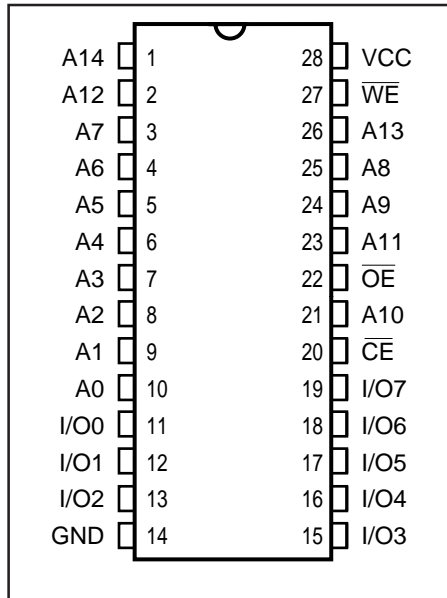
The IC62LV256 is pin compatible with other 32K x 8 SRAMs in 300mil DIP and SOJ, 330mil SOP, and 8*13.4mm TSOP-1 packages.

FUNCTIONAL BLOCK DIAGRAM

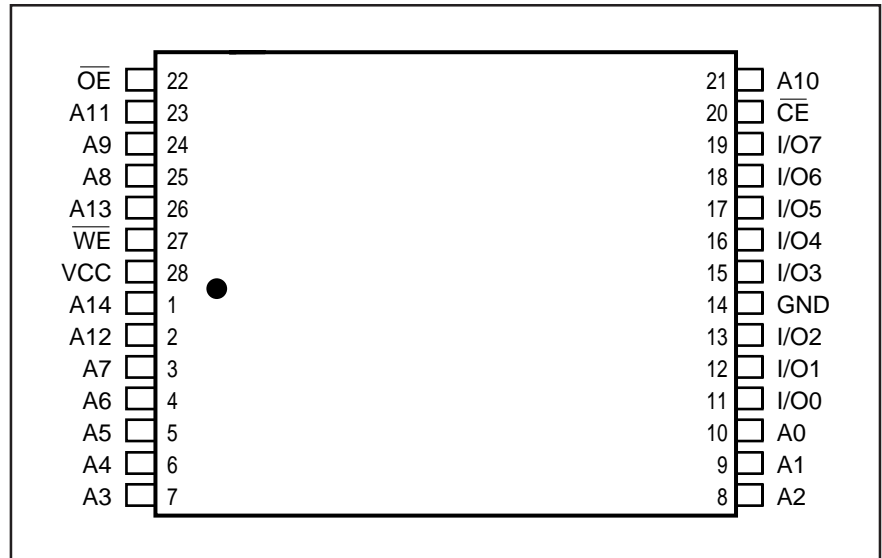


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PIN CONFIGURATION

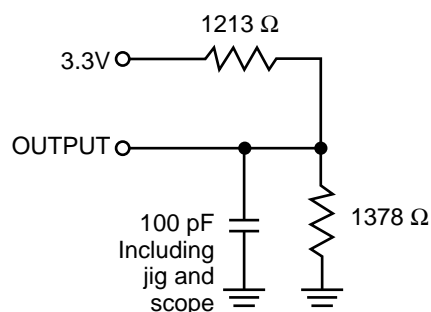

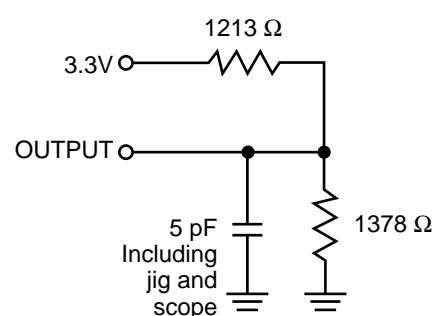
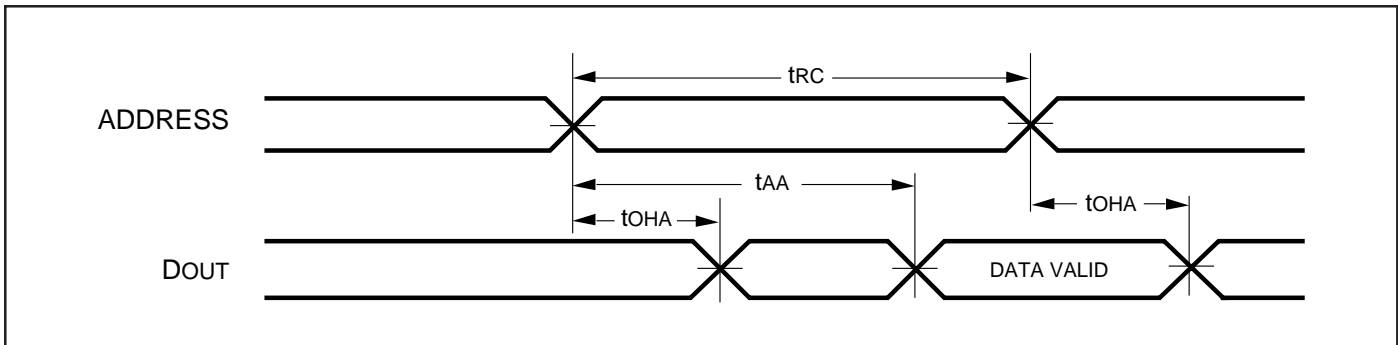


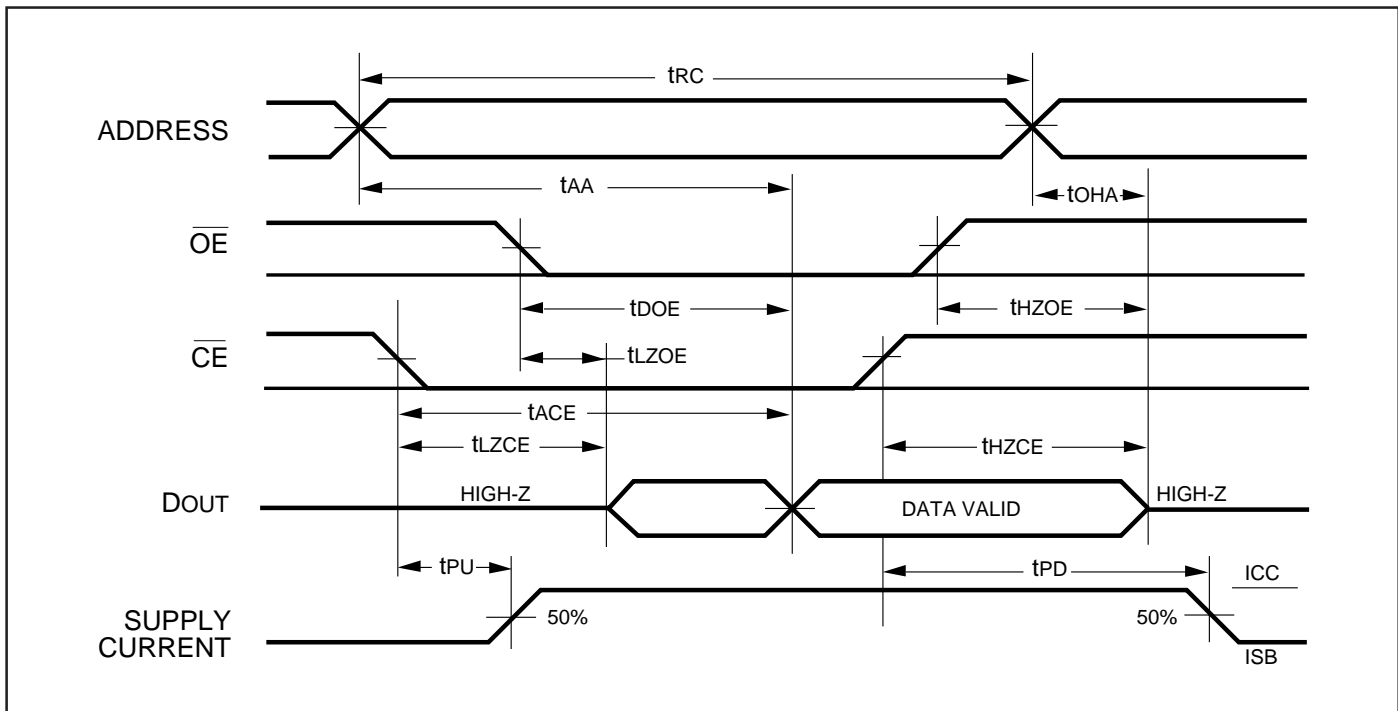

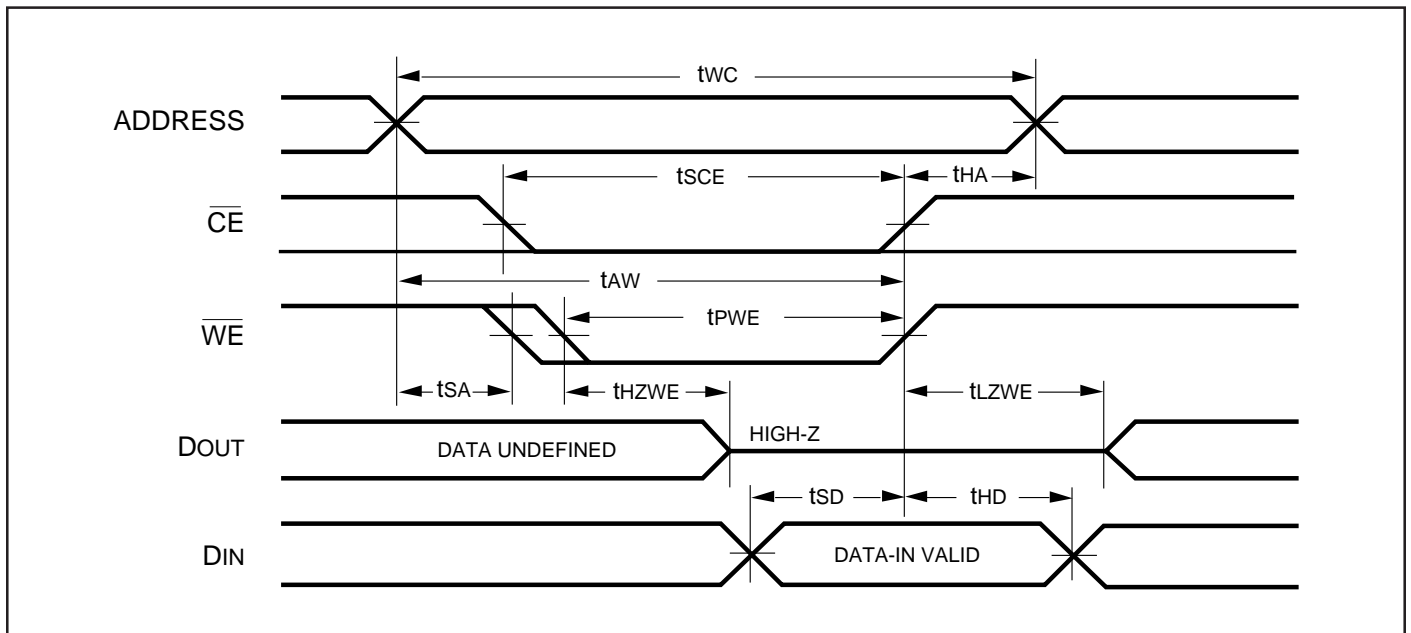

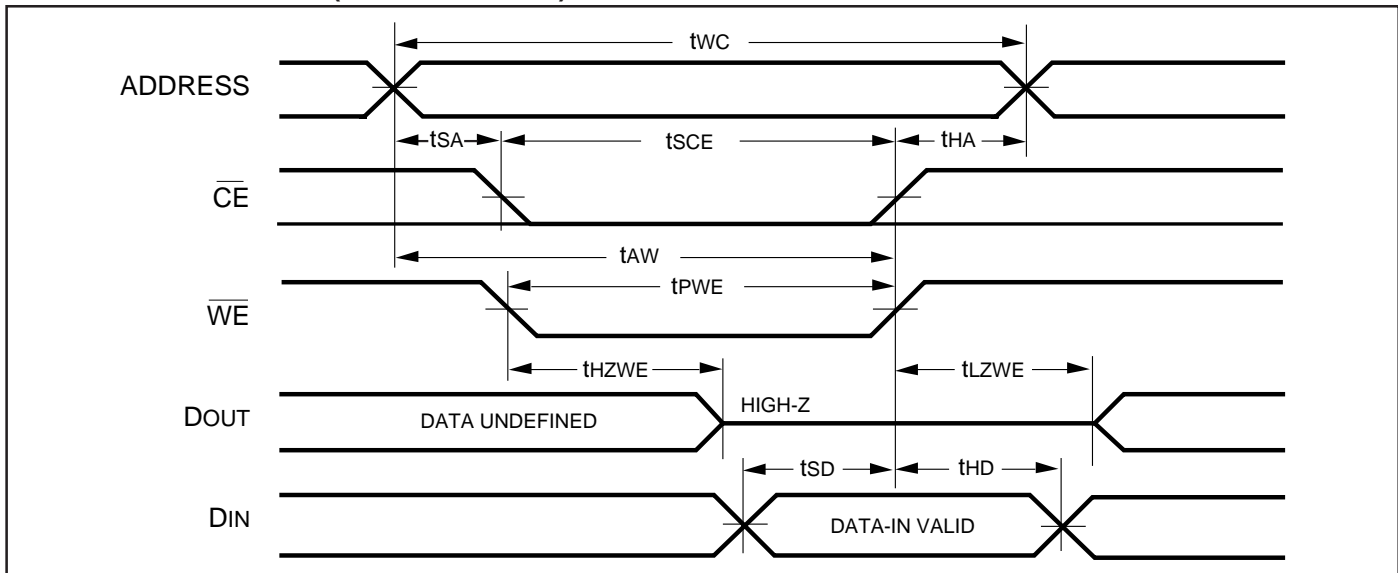
