



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TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS $T_A = 25$ °C, unless otherwise noted

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




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TYPICAL CHARACTERISTICS $T_A = 25$ °C, unless otherwise noted








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THERMAL RATINGS $T_A = 25 \text{ °C}$, unless otherwise noted
