





Handling Precaution

Usage Considerations

Let V_{th} be the voltage applied between gate and source that causes the drain current (I_D) to below -1 mA for the SSM3J36FS). Then, for normal switching operation, V_{GS(on)} must be higher than V_{th}, and V_{GS(off)} must be lower than V_{th}. This relationship can be expressed as: V_{GS(off)} < V_{th} < V_{GS(on)}.

Take this into consideration when using the device.


